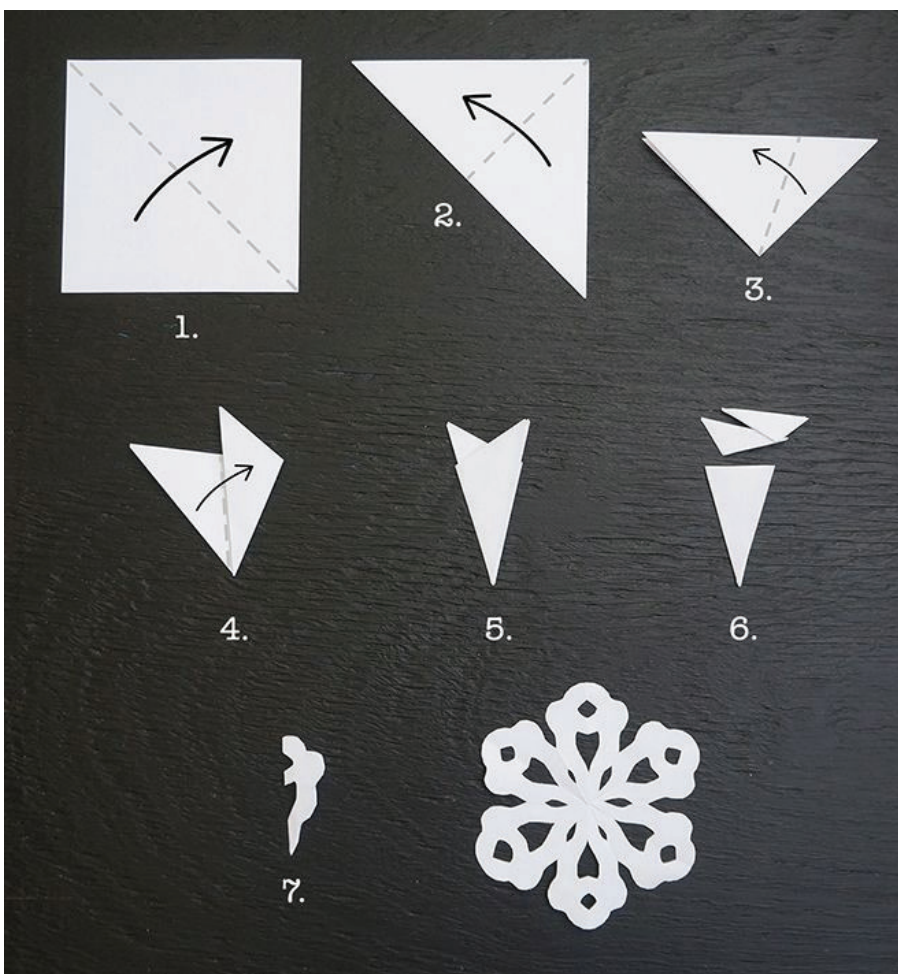


Hi Grade 5s!
